Traditional Greek village salad: cucumbers, tomatoes, onions, feta cheese, and Kalamata olives, served with pita bread.

Semolina custard wrapped in filo.

Nutella-filled, chocolate-dipped butter cookies.*

Chopped walnuts and spices rolled in filo. Topped with honey syrup and chocolate.

GALAKTOBOUREKO\$6
Custard pie topped with filo and honey syrup.

Shredded filo filled with chopped walnuts and spices. Topped with honey syrup.

Buttered almond cookies sprinkled with powdered sugar.

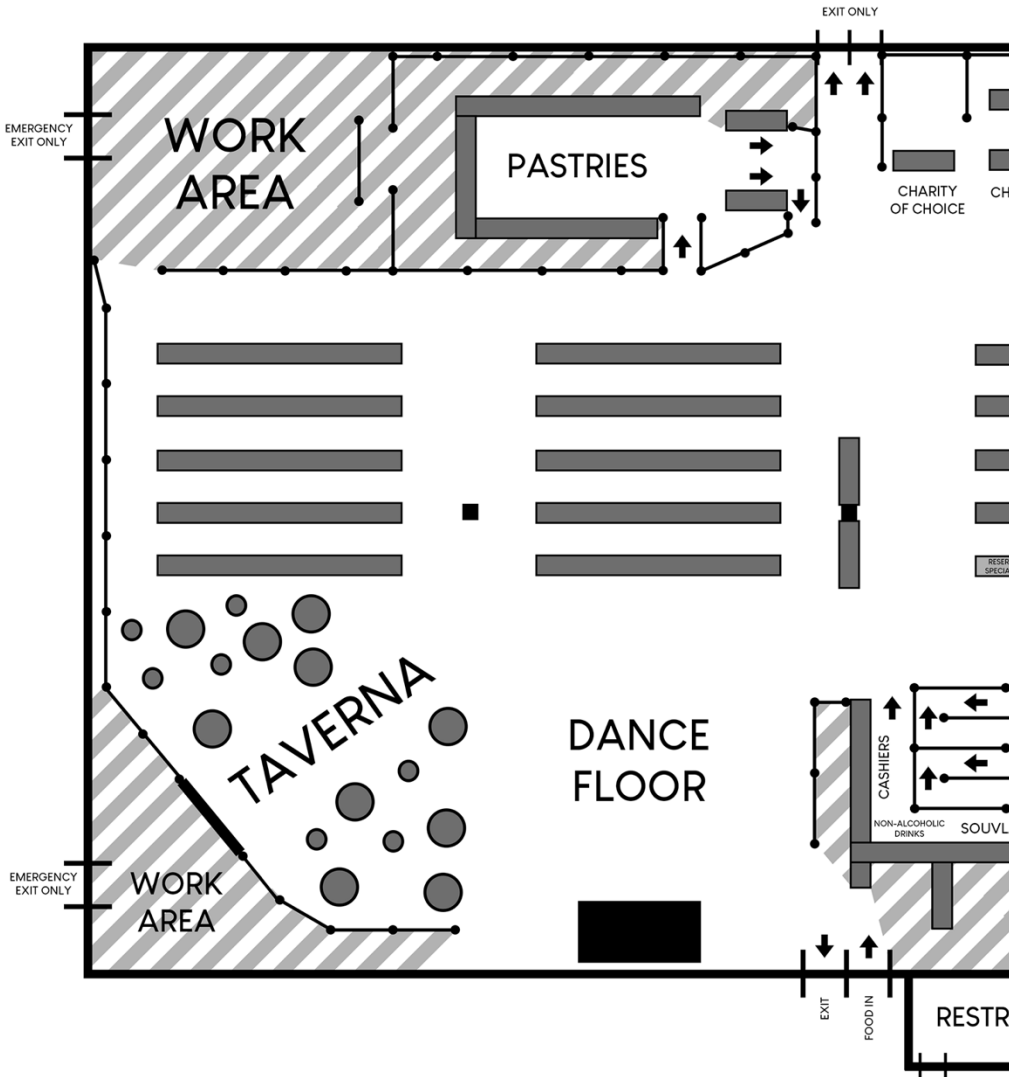

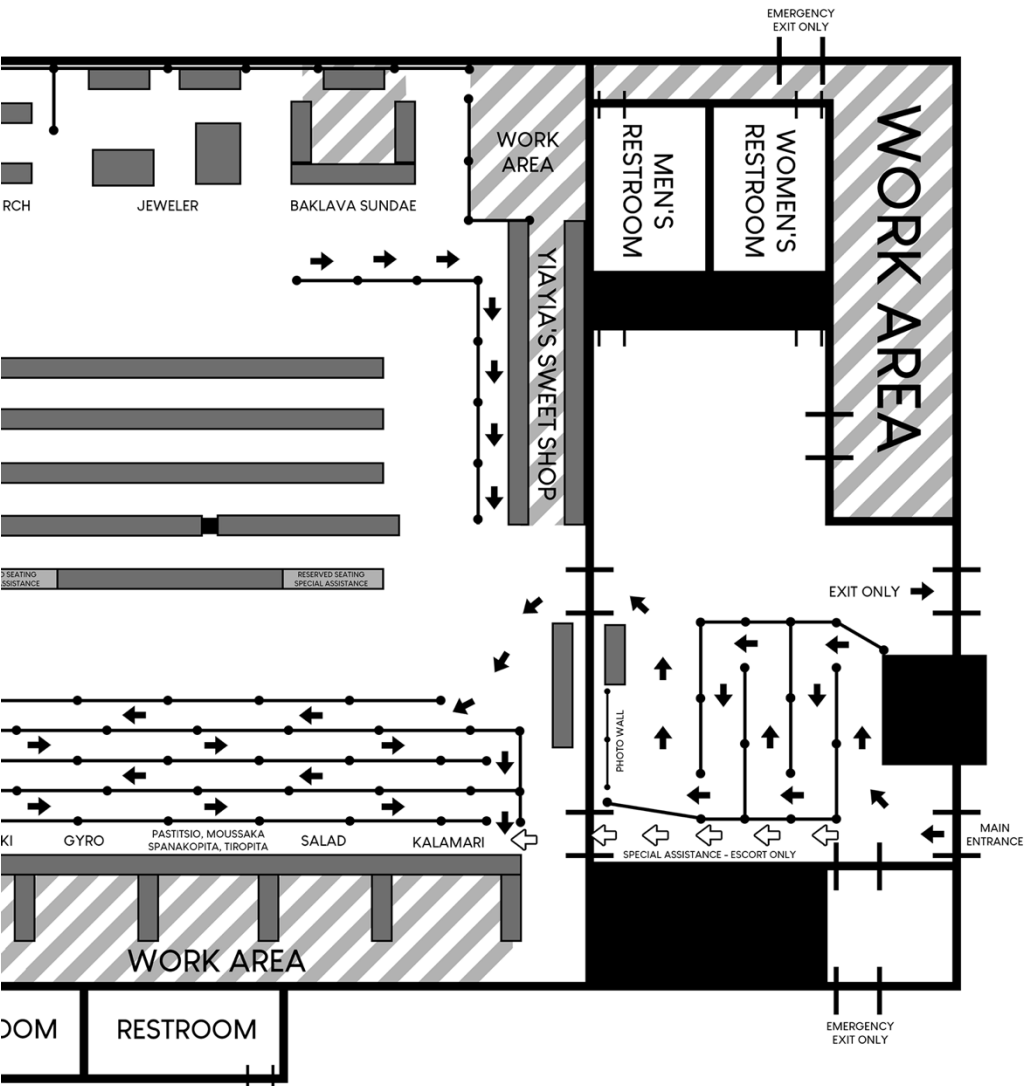
